

SDR & PERCS Pricing Structure, 2016-2020

For another year, we offer the same fees for SDR and PERCS to keep the life-saving surgery affordable to families around the world.

Children Who Need Only SDR

1. SDR SURGERY

We offer a fixed cost for the SDR surgery of **\$39,745**. The fixed cost covers:

1. Initial evaluation at the clinic
2. SDR surgery
3. Postoperative hospital care
4. Daily postoperative out-patient physical therapy for approximately three weeks.
5. Treatment of any postoperative complication **related to and as a consequence of** SDR surgery without additional charge

- The fixed SDR cost does not cover orthopedic surgery or any other medical services.
- There will be no additional billings, refunds, or itemized statements.
- If your child needs follow-up care in the future, separate payment will be required for those services.
- Any Emergency Room visits that are not a direct result of a complication of SDR surgery are not covered under the fixed cost. The costs associated with the ER visit should be paid for before you leave St. Louis. If you have travel insurance, we are typically not able to bill foreign travel insurance companies directly for services. You will have to pay all costs and then submit the receipts for reimbursement from the insurance company.

2. BRACES AND EQUIPMENT

You must pay a deposit **\$6,500** for braces and equipment such as walkers and canes.

Depending on the equipment you purchase, you may receive a refund or owe a balance. Any applicable refund will be processed approximately 90 days after the last date of service. If you owe a balance, you will need to pay the balance by a credit card or billing to your account before you leave St. Louis.

If bracing or other equipment is recommended, those items are purchased from various vendors for each child. SLCH does not sell braces or equipment. We do not charge a service fee. It is important for your child to follow our recommendations regarding bracing and equipment.

3. PAYMENT

Payment of the total amount of **\$46,245** (SDR + deposit for braces) is required no less than 45 days before your arrival at our hospital. If payment is not received, your surgery will be canceled or rescheduled.

If you wish to make payments in installments, we can arrange the payments before surgery. Please notify us once your child is accepted for surgery. If you choose to cancel surgery after you paid for the surgery, you will receive a refund.

We can also accept payments from multiple payers, but you will need to notify us once your child is accepted for surgery. The payers must all include the necessary identifying information per our instructions.

Children Who Need SDR and PERCS (Orthopedic Surgery)

If Dr. Park has recommended orthopedic surgery (PERCS) after SDR, the PERCS must be performed by Dr. Anderson at Mercy Hospital in St. Louis. If you prefer to have the recommended orthopedic surgery done in your country, we cannot accept your child for SDR with Dr. Park. We believe that the less invasive PERCS shortly after SDR is essential for the best possible outcomes of your child.

1. SDR SURGERY

The fixed cost for the SDR surgery is **\$39,745**.

The fixed cost covers:

1. Initial evaluation at the clinic
2. SDR surgery
3. Postoperative hospital care
4. Daily postoperative out-patient physical therapy for approximately three weeks.
5. Treatment of any postoperative complication **related to and as a consequence of** SDR surgery without additional charge

The fixed SDR cost does not cover orthopedic surgery or any other surgery.

There will be no additional billings, refunds, or itemized statements.

If your child needs follow-up care in the future, separate payment will be expected for those services.

You/your child may miss one PT visit on the day of Orthopedic surgery if scheduled for Percs. We are unable to provide a refund for any missed PT sessions, and we cannot schedule more than one hour of PT per day. Please let us know in advance if you wish to make up this PT session at the end of your stay.

2. PERCS SURGERY

The Cost of orthopedic surgery (PERCS) typically ranges from **\$8,191 - \$12,951**, depending on the extent of orthopedic surgery.

The cost covers:

- 1) initial evaluation with Dr. Anderson; 2) Orthopedic surgery at Mercy Hospital; 3) Overnight hospitalization after surgery if indicated; 4) Leg cast if needed; 5) Treatment of any complication directly related to orthopedic surgery.

If your child turns out to need orthopedic surgery less extensive than originally recommended, you will be refunded the difference from professional fees. If your child needs more extensive procedures than originally recommended, there will be no additional charge to you.

If bracing or other equipment is recommended, those items are purchased from various vendors for each individual child. SLCH does not sell braces or equipment. We do not charge a service fee. It is important for your child to follow our recommendations regarding bracing and equipment.

4. PAYMENT

Payment of the total amount (SDR + Orthopedic surgery + deposit for braces) is required no less than 45 days before the first date of service. If payment is not received, your surgery will be canceled or rescheduled. Kris Eddleston will send the invoice for SDR and bracing deposit and Mercy Hospital will send the invoice for Percs.

Children Who Need Only PERCS (Orthopedic Surgery)

1. PERCS SURGERY

The Cost of orthopedic surgery (PERCS) typically ranges from **\$8,191 - \$12,951** depending on the extent of orthopedic surgery.

The cost covers: 1) initial evaluation with Dr. Anderson; 2) Orthopedic surgery at Mercy Hospital; 3) Overnight hospitalization after surgery if indicated; 4) Leg cast if needed; 5) Treatment of any complication directly related to orthopedic surgery.

If your child turns out to need orthopedic surgery less extensive than originally recommended, you will be refunded the difference from professional fees. If your child needs more extensive procedures than originally recommended, there will be no additional charge to you.

These costs do not include any other services such as a return visit with Dr. Park, physical therapy, Ophthalmology, etc. These may be requested and paid for additionally.

BRACES

We will also collect a deposit of **\$6,500** for braces depending on the type of orthopedic surgery.

If your child will have heel cord lengthening (with or without hamstring lengthening procedure), you will need to deposit \$6,500 for braces, and remain in the St. Louis area for two (2) weeks to allow sufficient time for the braces to be shipped and fitted. You can purchase blocks of physical therapy for the stay in St. Louis (see below).

If your child will have only hamstring surgery, you may return home after three (3) days depending upon Dr. Anderson's recommendations. You may not need to deposit the \$6,500 for braces. You may not need to purchase physical therapy sessions.

Depending on the equipment you purchase, you may receive a refund or owe a balance. Any applicable refund will be processed approximately 90 days after the last date of service. If you owe a balance, you will need to pay the balance by a credit card or billing to your account before you leave St. Louis.

SLCH does not sell the braces and equipment. We purchase the items from outside vendors for each child. We do not charge any service fees.

2. PHYSICAL THERAPY

Patients who remain in St. Louis after surgery may choose to purchase physical therapy sessions.

Therapy Bundle Agreement: We offer you a therapy bundle option that covers a 90 minute PT evaluation at the cost of \$225 and a 1-hour session of outpatient therapy at the cost of \$115 per hour. You can select different blocks of treatment sessions: 3 session block, 5 session block or 8 session block. Individual therapy sessions are not available. The Therapy Bundle prices cover physical, occupational and speech therapy sessions. Special OT and ST evaluations are charged according to the complexity and are not covered under the bundling agreement.

The entire completed and signed Therapy Bundle Agreement must be returned to Kris Eddleston kris.eddleston@bjc.org to be eligible for the TherapyBundle special pricing. Once you have paid for a selected option, no money will be refunded for any unused sessions. Any unused sessions will remain on your account for one year from the start date.

Additional physical therapy blocks may be requested during your visit and must be paid for at the time of service in the Therapy Department by credit card.

3. PAYMENT

Payment of the total cost is required no less than 45 days prior to the first date of service. If payment is not received by the deadline, your surgery may be canceled or rescheduled.

The typical total cost for orthopedic surgery **\$8,191 - \$12,951** (+ deposit for braces + physical therapy) will be different in each child. Based on the type of recommended orthopedic surgery Mercy Hospital will be responsible for providing you with the total cost. Any bracing deposit, physical therapy and/or return visit with Dr. Park will be billed by Kris Eddleston.
